Organization and Membership Committee:

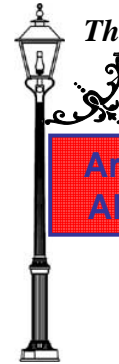

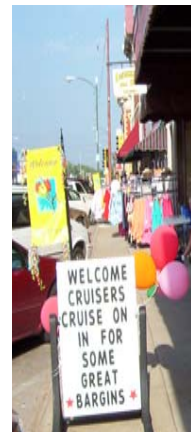
