To recruit and develop new leadership, new membership, to attract a large number of volunteers and to raise funds for the program’s ongoing operation and special projects.

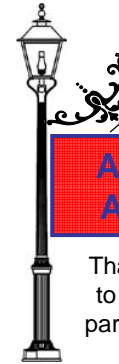
